Long Cane Creek, Savannah River Drainage
Saturday, November 10, 2018

Greetings FishHeads!

We have organized an outing to experience some of the local piscine diversity in the middle Savannah River drainage in the form of Long Cane Creek (one trib to the north of Stevens Creek). We will have a few dipnets and a couple of seines, and a few sets of extra waders, but bring your personal gear for the best results. Mussels are a potential find, as well as other aquatic and riparian taxa.

Parking at the location is ample, but carpooling is encouraged! We will be departing the state park at 9am, and the site is about 30 min away.

Where: Bridge on West Charleston Road, approximately 7 miles NNW of the town of McCormick – coordinates **34.000505, -82.352133** map <https://goo.gl/maps/6qsKyAxUmJF2>
